This half-day event, held at Bethpage High School in Bethpage, NY, introduces participants to critical thinking about ethical issues. Teams of five high school students will compete as they answer questions about relevant ethical issues.

Participating schools will receive cases and resources in advance of the competition so that teams and coaches can review and analyze the cases to determine their positions; and to come up with supporting arguments, examples and further questions.

Environmental Ethics
Cyberethics
Media Ethics
Corporate Corruption
Protection of Privacy
The Ethics of Governing
